

## **LINDEN PROJECTS SPACE**

Linden Projects Space launched in August 2019. The space is available for hire and has been designed to create exhibition opportunities for artists and curators living and working on the Southside of Melbourne. We also welcome applications from artists and curators from other areas, though those living and working in the City of Port Phillip will be given preference. We seek applications from artists and curators to apply for group or solo exhibitions.

Linden Projects Space is a unique space. We are working in partnership with the University of Melbourne and will be providing an Arts Industry Placement program for postgraduate students. Masters students from Arts and Cultural Management and Art Curatorship courses will be mentored by the Linden team to provide them hands on experience to assist with career development.

Please note:

- > The gallery is located on the second floor at the rear of Linden New Art.
- > This space is not accessible for people in wheelchairs.
- > There is a small goods lift to transport items upstairs – all other equipment will need to be carried up two flights of stairs.
- > artists planning to show multimedia work must supply all AV equipment.

> Applications may include work in any medium.

All artworks:

- > Must be new work
- > Not previously exhibited
- > Can be for sale. Linden New Art takes a 20% commission plus GST on all sales.

### **HIRE FEE**

- > \$1,500 plus GST
- > Fee includes: 1 day of professional installation assistance, exhibition installation photography, social media promotion and an e-invitation sent to Linden New Art's mailing list of over 3000 people.

### **APPLICATION ASSESSMENT PROCESS**

A committee made up of key Linden staff and external representatives within the arts industry will meet to assess all applications to ensure they are:

- > suitable for the space
- > explore new ideas and different ways of thinking.
- > provide a diverse array of exhibitions for visitors to enjoy

### **APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE**

- > Exhibition title
- > Exhibition proposal (300 words) outlining the ideas and themes that your exhibition will explore.
- > Exhibition design (150 words) - Describe how many works you plan to present, their size, medium and how you propose to display them in the space
- > Brief biography of all curators and artists involved in the project
- > 6 images of works or weblinks to video works that will be included in your exhibition (confirmed or indicative)
